# REMOVAL OF TREE (T1) AND 30% CROWN REDUCTION TO TREE (T2) SITUATED WITHIN A CONSERVATION AREA MECHLIN, INKERMAN TERRACE, WHITEHAVEN

I refer to your application of the 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2025 under the above Tree Preservation Order for consent to carry out the following work:-

### **DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL**

Removal of the Thuja occidentalis is recommended to improve Mahonia. T02: Fagus sylvatica 'purpurea' growing adjacent to building currently overhangs house roof line despite still being small proportional to potential terminal size. Evidence of previous pruning wounds indicates specimen has been reduced before. Recommendation of 30% crown reduction.' |
