Activities Statement

The building is used for the purpose of housing beef cattle.

The building is utilised for the principal purpose of fattening up of Beef Stock.

Beef Stock are occasionally breed on site: which is not uncommon for a working farm.

All Beef Stock go to slaughter.

No Beef Stock go to auction.

There is no association with Ulverston Auction Mart.

All processes on site are normal activities for a beef farm

Machinery Usage

Barley is now processed within new shed (latest planning permission).

Generally, there is no crushing after 7 o'clock in the evening.

Machinery usage is voluntarily generally restricted to between 7:30am – 7:00pm.

Machinery operations take place approx. 40min a day maximum.

As per the appended NFU Letter, work starts on the farm at 6.30 am and finishes at 6.30 pm however, to comply with animal welfare on occasions some activities may be carried out outside these hours
