T1, T2, T3, T4 are all Ash trees grow on Beckbrow. These are all situated at the edge of the bordered garden area. The other side of the trees is a large drop down of ground levels. This over time has resulted in the large rocks been exposed. We propose to have these PTO



trees cut down owing to the size of trees, the exposure of roots and the position of these trees near to Beckbrow barn and neighbouring property of Braw House.

The concern is that in the high winds we have the trees get blown down/break and fall onto one of the properties causing severe damage.

Our intent would be to replant a hedge along the bottom of the garden area but away from the exposed edge and to keep it to a certain so as not to get to a large height again.

A1 - This is a very large Norway Spruce tree sitting near the top of field area at Midburn. It has a very large mushroom shaped top on the tree which is our concern. In high winds the movement is great and with the weight of the mushroom top concern that this could cause the tree to ~~stop~~<sup>snap</sup> a break causing damage to close by property on Lowrey Close. There was a smaller tree nearer to this which did snap some years ago although with its position it didn't cause damage to property.

B2 + B3. These two trees are on the border of Beckbrow to Midburn field. B3 is a dead tree growing into B2. These are both Ash trees. our concern is the height of these trees + the possibility of the breaking in the high winds. If these trees were to break + fall they are most likely to fall on to Byre, Midburn which has an asbestos roof. We feel by having them cut down in a safe manner is best and then we will replant the area with hedgey trees which will be maintained and kept in control.

C1 - is a ~~large~~ sycamore tree which has grown out from the wall of Midtown Barn. After this is a very large tree and if falls could fall & damage Midtown byre Asbestos roof. The movement in the tree in high winds also has the possible chance to cause damage to the sandstone Barn of Midtown.

All tree works will be carried out by Tree Surgeon.
