Other neighbours are boat owners, some of whom live on board and occupy year-round berthings which they rent from our tenants Whitehaven Marina Limited. This group of people were invited to a community engagement event at The Edge in summer, in conjunction with a training course organised by the Marina team. We have published regular updates about The Edge in general for the wider community to read, though not specifically about the external signage.

Details of the pre-application advice received
We meet regularly with Nick Hayhurst to discuss all manner of harbour activities and developments. We've kept him updated on our signage proposals from an early stage and have been guided on which types of signage would require planning permission and which ones wouldn't. A colleague of mine had held previous discussions with Nick before the date stated here, but that colleague then left our organisation, so I followed up to check how far the application had progressed, which was when I learned it hadn't yet been submitted. I sought Nick's reassurance over the type of sign and illumination levels that were being proposed, and asked about the decision-making process and likely timescales. I explained my colleague had seemingly commissioned the signage prior to seeking permission, due to the long lead-in times and The Edge finally confirming its opening date for this month. However, these are still in production and not yet installed, so this is not yet a retrospective application as such.
