Sycamore (number 1 on survey plan) - Reduce Crown at roadside to balance and reduce weight on weak stem junctions
Oak (number 2 on survey plan) - One sided crown growth reduce branch weight above road
Oak (number 5 on survey plan) - Lightly reduce ends of lower branches, especially nearest houses
Field Maple (number 6 on survey plan) - Remove stake, guard and several low branches
Oak (number 7 on survey plan) - Remove lower Epicormic growth up to 3m and crown clean
Field Maple (number 8 on survey plan) - Formative prune - remove 2 low branches
Oak (number 9 on survey plan) - Crown clean of dead wood and die back
Ash (number 10 on survey plan) - Advance decay further to survey report, decay has been discovered vertically as well as horizontally with the main trunk
request to fell and kill root for safety given location and proximity to main trunk road should the tree fail and replant a small oak in main area away from drains
