Part removal of existing 500mm high boundary wall spanning gable end of the property, replaced with 1.8m high hit and miss panelled fence. Pin kerb stones to be installed in front of fence against adjoining pavement where existing brick wall is to be removed. Fence panels to be natural in colour and of hit and miss construction to allow both light and wind to pass through and remain strong enough to cope with the wind loadings the property is exposed too. Fence to span from the south east corner of the garden to parallel with the property and back to the gable end of the house, 3 metres from the front of the property.
