tree 342. Acer pseudoplatanus, (sycamore) mature two stemmed tree that has dye back of 70% of the total crown volume. After close inspection it has been noted that trunk on the East side is 100% died off and the top branches are breaking off in high winds the West side trunk is starting showing signs of die back and 50% of crown is now died back. only removing the dead parts would leave the tree in a very Vulnerable and unbalanced shape and condition that would not provide a recovery. It be against good practice to remove at least 70 % of the tree. The tree is situated in a very busy visited site and removal of the tree is

to be recommended before leaf growth.

Main trunk has visual signs of decay and cavities present at 4m above ground and before removal a climbing bat inspection will take place. As part of the CBC tree strategy we will replace the removed tree with three suitable new trees in the same area.
