Tree is Fraxinus excelsior - common Ash (See T1 on sketch plan). Tree is most likely a self seeded plant which is growing in cracks of paved area (See photo A). Tree Showing signs of Ash die-back (see Photo C)

Garden is terraced (4 terraces), tree located on second terrace. Tree base is at the same level as 2nd floor of houses, aprox 10 metres from house, aprox 5 metres from out building of no 16 and 17 fox house road (see PhotoB). Tree is multi stemmed, girth at base is 18 inches and 15 inches (two stemmed tree) (see Photo D). Tree height is aprox 11 metres from base of tree (see Photo B).

Description of works - aim to remove tree. dismantle tree and remove tree root. Reinstate paved area.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.

- mark the position of the tree(s) to which you want to carry out work and identify them by the number shown in the Tree Preservation Order where possible; if you use a different number, please make sure that this can be matched with your description of the tree(s)
- if there are many trees on the site, make clear which tree(s) are included in this application by:
 - o marking all trees on the plan, but only numbering those to which you want to carry out work
 - o showing the approximate distance between the application tree(s) and buildings
 - o adding other relevant features on the site (e.g. greenhouse, paths)
