

4 Oxford Close – Lime Opinion

It is my professional opinion that crown lifting the lower branches of the Lime overhanging the rear garden of 4 Oxford Close is beneficial from an amenity standpoint.

There is some deadwood build-up within these branches over the garden area which could fall. The continued elongation and sagging of these branches is also of detriment to the usability of the garden area below. Removal of these overhanging branches eliminates potential future hazards and maintains garden usability.

Crown raising and epicormic growth removal are standard management practices for Limes in urban settings. The reduction to overall tree volume is minor and should not cause negative impact on tree health.
