It is proposed that biodiversity net gain (BNG) for the offsetting of the construction of a new shed / workshop at the site 'Land at Brewery Brow' is done in the immediate vicinity, around the new building.

The site of the new shed / workshop was classified as Ruderal/ Ephemeral (sparsely vegetated land). It is proposed that the offsetting site (of equal size) with a base line classification of sparsely vegetated grassland will be enhanced to a modified grassland: wildflower meadow (rated as 'good' quality). This on-site enhancement would provide the biodiversity net gain required to offset the works.

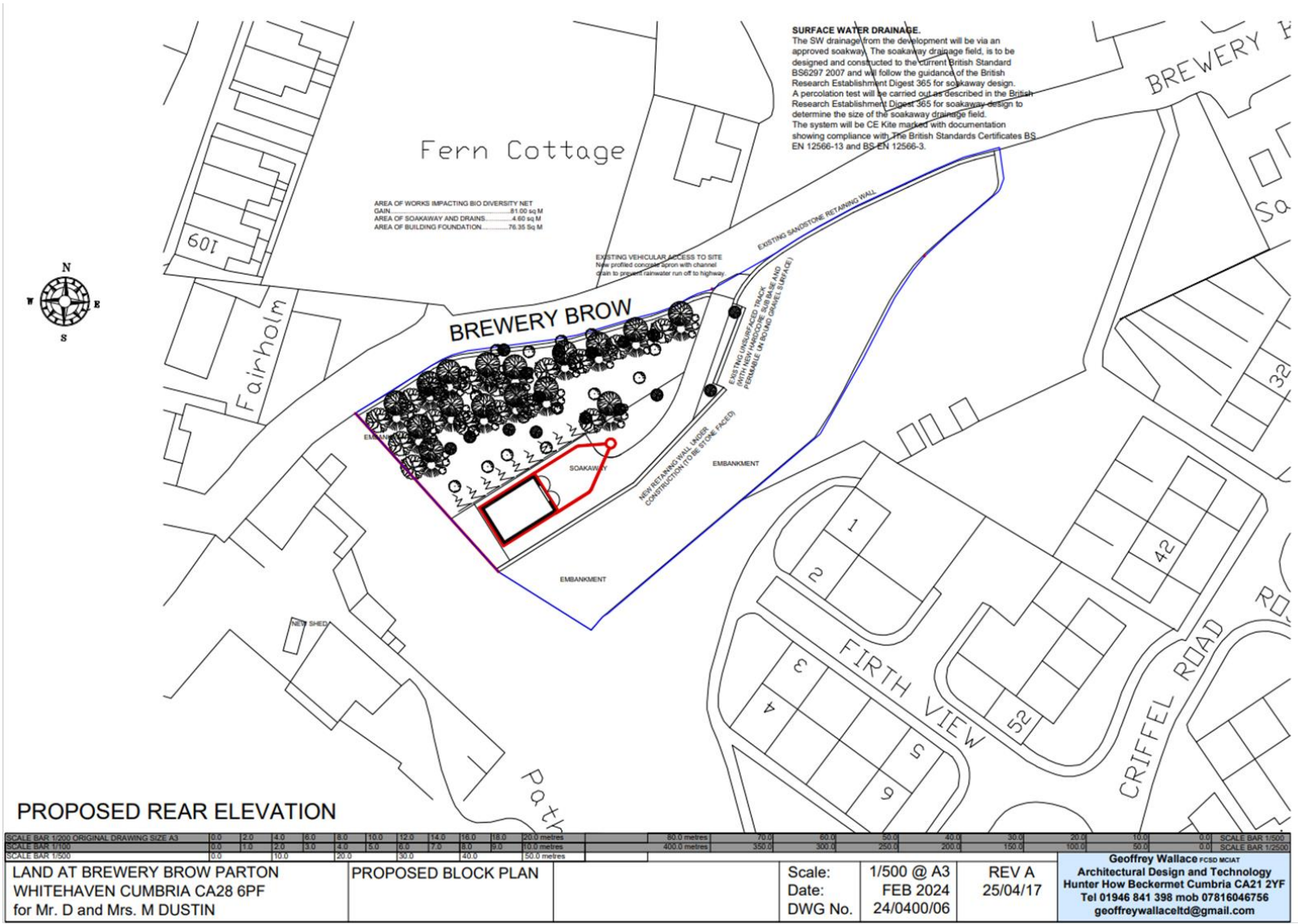


Figure 3 – Site of BNG, before net gain

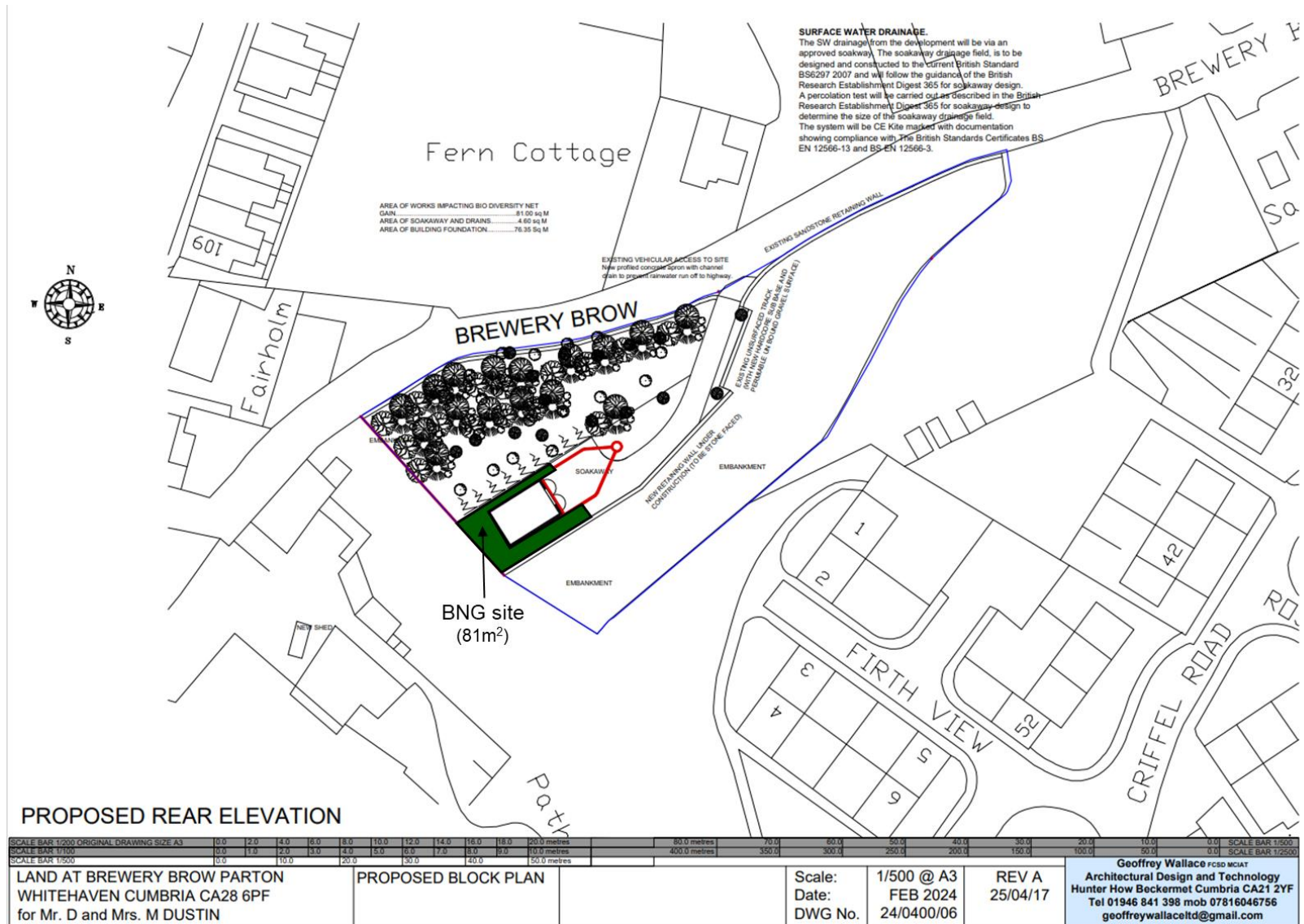


Figure 4 – Site of BNG, after net gain
