Construction Method/Environment Management Plan

- Where practical and possible 2 meter high secure protective barrier of galvanised tube & mesh infill type fence will be used to secure the construction site. The factory area is now protected from the pubic entering the site by a security fence around the perimeter. All construction vechilse and material storage will be secure within the construction compound.
- Due to the side being located adjacent to the Duddon Estuary SSSI site and the
 possible presence of Natter jack toads the base of the perimeter fence will be
 covered with a continuous plastic sheet approximately 500mm high with the bottom
 edge sealed with soil to prevent ingress of said species during the works.
- Site operations will maintain a clean and tidy site at all times. Work to be planned
 with due consideration to weather conditions avoiding excessive wet/ dry spells to
 reduce the possibility of dirty water run off and dust nuisance.
- Means of access for deliveries to be via the existing tarmac road to the entrance of Slacks Millom Ltd
- Deliveries and Works to take place between 7.30am and 17.30pm Monday to Friday
- Existing Public footpath 405121 will remain unimpeded as the construction can be done on site.
- All waste materials will be disposed of in covered skips and be removed from site by sheeted lorries.
- Contractors to control dust, noise and vibrations. Water will be used to supress dust when cutting concrete and face masks to a minimum of FFP3 to be used also.
- Refuelling, concrete mixing, material, waste storage to be as far away from the boundary with the Duddon estuary as possible.
- Contractors to be made aware of the possible presence of Natterjack toads and regular checks to be made when moving material, equipment or beginning works in any area.
- Any trenchwork, excavations etc left overnight to be either covered or provided with planks at 45% to aid escape for toads ect, and said areas to be checked for the presence of toads the next morning or before commencing works
