The Environmental Health team has no objections to the above development. Noise and dust from demolition / construction works could be problematic to neighbours, so we would request that the following conditions are applied if the development is approved –

• Noise from construction works

All works and ancillary operations that are audible at the site boundary shall only be carried out between the hours of 08.00 to 18.00 Monday to Friday and 08.00 to 13.00 hours on Saturday and at no time on Sunday or Bank Holidays, unless otherwise agreed with the Local Planning Authority.

• Dust and airborne pollutants

Control measures for dust and other air-borne pollutants during construction works shall be implemented at all times.
