Thank you for consulting me on the additional/amended information submitted for the above application.

Comments I made in a letter to you dated 28 March 2024 are still considered appropriate.

There are reasonable grounds to consider that the construction of the proposed development will impact upon significant archaeological assets. As no information has been supplied with the application on the significance of any archaeological assets that survive within the site nor how any such remains will be impacted upon by the proposed development, I recommend that this information is supplied **prior to the determination of the application**. I advise that an archaeological evaluation of site should be commissioned which will provide information that is proportionate to both the significance of the assets and to the scale of impact of the proposed development. An informed judgement can be made as to whether, in the event planning consent is granted, it is necessary to include provisions for the preservation of significant archaeological assets or the recording of assets of lesser interest affected by the proposal.
