Thank you for your consultation letter of 13 June 2023 seeking the further views of the Coal Authority on the above planning application.

The Coal Authority Response: Material Consideration

You will recall from our consultation response letter of 13 October 2022 that we raised no objection to the application despite the lack of a Coal Mining Risk Assessment. This was on the basis that the proposal would primarily entail the change of use of an existing building. Whilst a pool is to be created at ground floor level within the building, these works would take place outside the Development High Risk.

It is noted that further revised plans have now been received by the LPA. The Coal Authority's Planning & Development Team has **no specific comments** to make regarding these plans. We do however consider that our comments and recommendation (for the imposition of an informative note on the decision notice), set out in our letter of 13 October 2022 remain valid and relevant to the decision making process.
