Dear Sir/ Madam,

I was discussing a possible planning application for a small wind powered water pump with Demi Crawford towards the end of last year. I believe she copied Development Control in to the last email she sent before going on maternity leave, so hopefully you have a paper trail of what was discussed. As I mentioned to Demi, I would usually have got Alan Walker to submit planning applications for us but he was ill at the time and has unfortunately passed away since. I have therefore filled in the application myself, so if you require any further information, please do not hesitate to contact me and I will do my best to supply what is needed. See a brief description of the proposal below:

The water pump is to be situated in a field (RPA number SD1983 1041) near to the animal husbandry shed shown on the Site Plans. The clean water from the existing field drains would run in to the pump. To power the pump there would be a small windmill on top of it, with a height of 4.327 metres. This would pump the clean water to supply drinking water for the animals in the husbandry shed and to field troughs. Any excess water would be returned to the field drainage system.
