Thank you for the e-mail with comments from the EA & the councils Flood engineer.

Firstly. Please find enclosed a copy of 'Issue 2' Flood Risk Assessment.

I hope I've covered most of their concerns??

Second I interpret the Council's Flood engineers comments as stating facts, with no concerns except the last 3. (I've marked up 1,2,3 on copy of letter)

1) The existing septic tank is large enough to cater for the annex + exist bungalow. as per 'Foul water treatment notes on sh/t 1 of dwg 1770'. Combining the 2 units with a common drainage field causes less problems than providing a 2nd foul treatment & the distance they would need be apart. The treatment conforms to the General Binding Rules.

2+3) I've enclosed a copy of Rainwater soakaway codes but there was one provided with the original application.

These code form is used for B. Regs.

Its only if soakaways are rubble filled type that each hole needs to be 1.824 cu m capacity. When using aggregate crates, the capacity only needs to exceed 0.364 m³ * in this case 0.6 cu m crates.
