Demolition of former public house and rebuilding of new office facility

Thank you for the above planning consultation.

There are no objections to this proposed development from Environmental Health. As per our response to the previous planning application, Planners may wish to condition the demolition / construction hours of working, though the property is of detached configuration and there are no immediate neighbours.

The following condition may therefore be considered:

- Noise from demolition / construction works

Following approval of the development, demolition and construction activities that are audible at the site boundary shall be carried out only between the following hours Monday to Friday 08.00 – 18.00 and Saturday 08.00 – 13.00 and at no time on Sunday or Bank Holiday.

Deliveries to and removal of plant, equipment, machinery and waste from the site must only take place within the permitted hours detailed above unless otherwise agreed with the Local Planning Authority.

Reason: In the interests of the amenities of surrounding occupiers during the construction of the development.
