Water suppression and dust mitigation measures should be employed during the demolition works, and Environmental Health would request that no crushing of waste materials is carried out on this site.

If heras fencing is erected around the site perimeter, debris mesh netting should also be provided to prevent the escape of any wind-blown debris (such as lightweight cavity wall insulation material) produced during the demolition process.
