Thank you for the above planning consultation.

We have no objections to the proposed development.

In order to limit noise intrusion to neighbours during any construction works, we would request that the construction working hours are limited –

- Noise from construction works

Following approval of the development, construction activities that are audible at the site boundary shall be carried out only between the following hours Monday to Friday 08.00 – 18.00 and Saturday 08.00 – 13.00 and at no time on Sunday or Bank Holiday.

Deliveries to and removal of plant, equipment, machinery and waste from the site must only take place within the permitted hours detailed above unless otherwise agreed with the Local Planning Authority.

Reason: In the interests of the amenities of surrounding occupiers during the construction of the development.
