


Please see photos and associated notes of similarities and differences of a similar ventilation system we propose to install at 1a South Parade, Seascale (4/23/20290F1). The below system is located in Frizington, Cumbria and has some similarities to what we propose.





Although the ducting, flue and cowel are almost identical in design to what we propose, there are some key differences;

- 1) Our system will vent around 3 metres higher than this system. Given that 1a South Parade is the tallest property in the immediate area, gases will not be emitted below any other neighbouring roof line.
- 2) Our system will become visible once it emits from the rear single storey, meaning no-one can access or touch it at ground floor level.
- 3) The prevailing westerly wind direction blows away from other commercial and residential properties meaning that the majority of the time, not only will fumes be emitted vertically, but they will be carried away from neighbouring properties rather than towards them.
- 4) Our ducting, flue and cowel will be painted to match the other services and pipework already present on the building.
