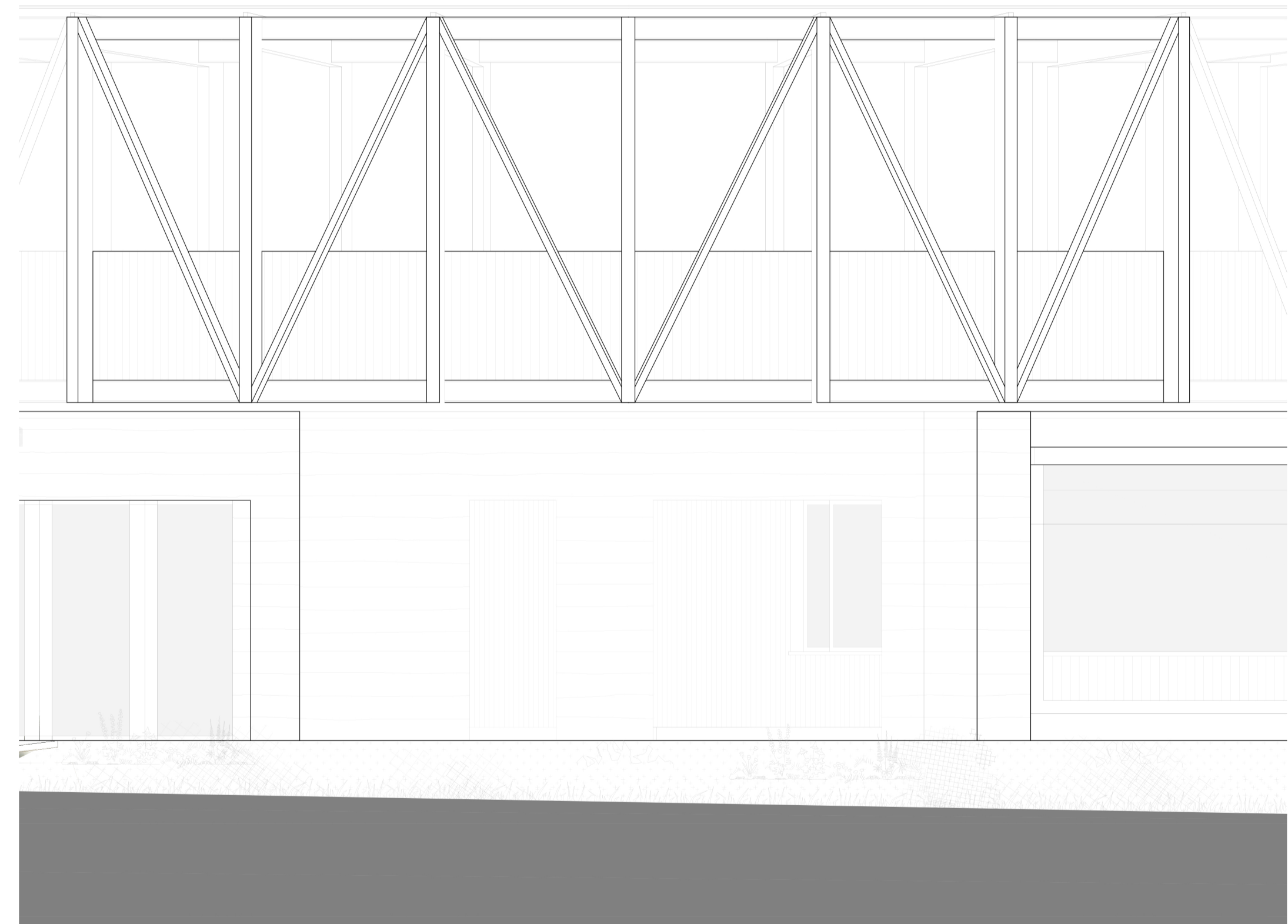
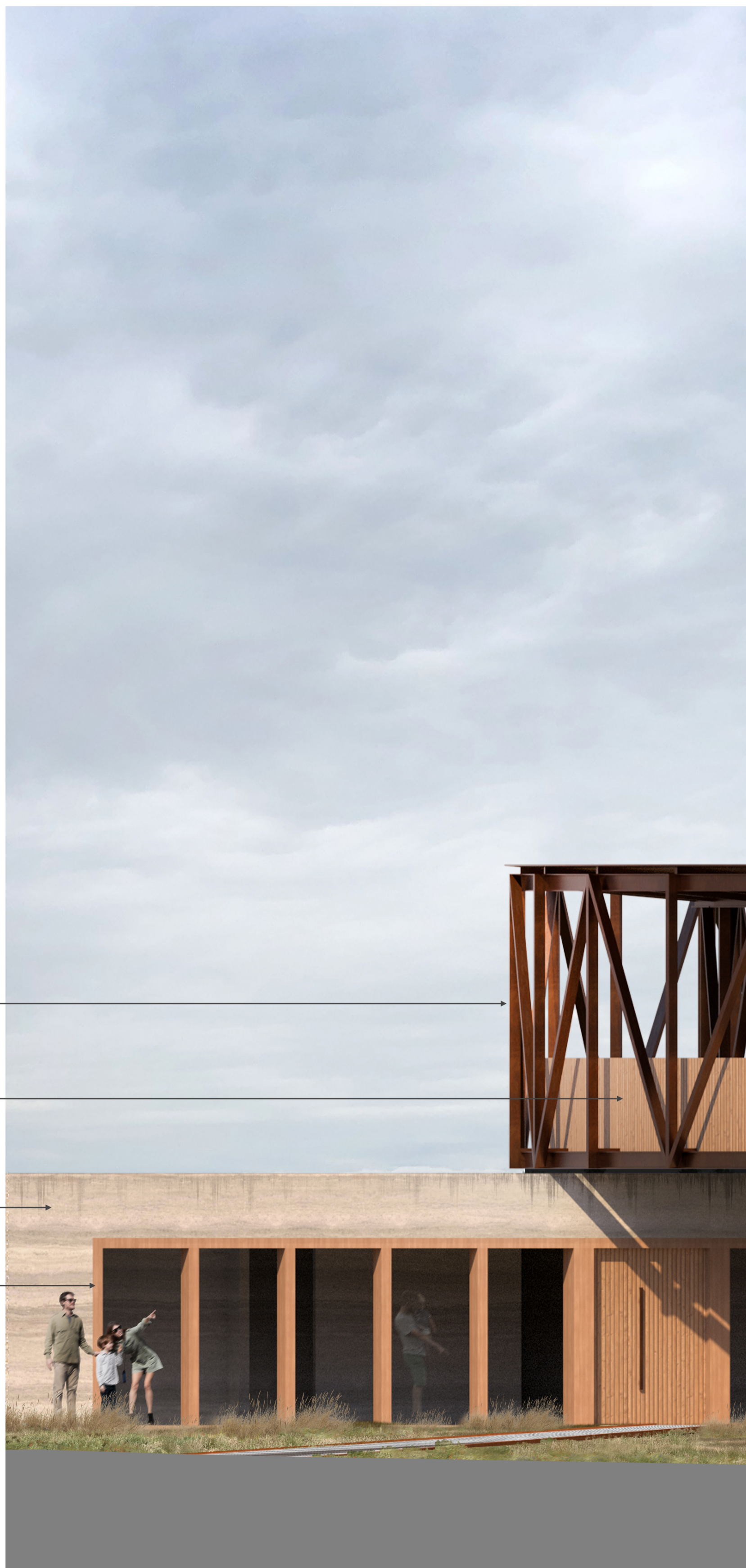


Rotunda
Expressed steel structure finished in a dark ferrous oxide-coloured protective coating which will reflect the industrial heritage of the site while being durable in the exposed setting.

Balustrade screen
Accoya timber slatting, unfinished and allowed to weather to a silver-grey tone over time. Accoya is a thermally treated timber and has a high durability suitable to a coastal location like this.

Low level walls
Rammed concrete walls using site-found slag and limestone to achieve a tonal balance and varying layering to reflect the strata and geology of the ground.

Glazing and Infill panels
Accoya frames, mullions, infill panels and doors to the lower level accommodation.
