ADDENDUM DOCUMENT TO SUPPORT PLANNING AND LBC APPLICATION FOR THE OLD CUSTOMS HOUSE, WHITEHAVEN

Roof coverings:

Roof to harbourside – this is to remain in graduated green slate roof –

Specification:

Existing slate roof to be stripped off, existing roofing battens and felt to be discarded.

Existing slate to be re-gauged and prepared for re-fitting – new slate may required for make up of roof covering and this will be like for like re-claimed green slate.

The roof will be re-laid in diminishing courses, with 25 x 50mm sw treated battens on breathable roofing membrane.

Ridge – existing ridge to be re-bedded on mortar.

New code 4 leadwork flashings and soakers cut into existing chimney and Party Wall

Roof to Rear Car Park – this is to remain in blue welsh slate roof –

Specification:

Existing slate roof to be stripped off, existing roofing battens and felt to be discarded.

Existing slate to be re-gauged and prepared for re-fitting – new slate may required for make up of roof covering and this will be like for like re-claimed blue slate.

25 x 50mm sw treated battens on breathable roofing membrane.

Ridge – existing ridge to be re-bedded on mortar.

New code 4 leadwork flashings and soakers cut into existing chimney and Party Wall

Rooflights:

Velux Conservation Rooflights (black) size $550 \times 780 \text{mm}$ size with recessed flashing trim

Render:

New blockwork walls to rear wall outriggers to be in traditional sand / cement render with block courses lined in to match existing – finish: - painted to match existing.
