2 Introduction

Context: This Materials Management Plan (MMP) has been prepared in accordance with CL:AIRE's Definition of Waste: Development Industry Code of Practice. It forms Appendix J of the Remediation Statement Appendix L – Stockpiles Investigation, Former Albright and Wilson Works, Whitehaven, Cumbria. It has been prepared to enable the execution of regrading works and redeployment of existing stockpiled materials within the site.

Scope: Rhodia UK Limited ("Rhodia") intends to reuse stockpiled materials at the former Albright and Wilson Site to reduce safety risks to future public users of the site, current employees, contractors and any possible trespassers. The steepest slopes currently have a gradient of less than 1 in 1 (<45 degrees). The risks associated with the steep slopes have been considered in a Trespasser Risk Assessment already completed by Rhodia. All new slopes created are to have a gradient not exceeding 1 in 3.
