Comments:

This building is a local landmark built in traditional materials and style. It should be preserved and used as a model for other developments due to be built nearby. If the building cannot be saved it should be rebuilt like for like on the same footprint in the same style using the same materials.

Likewise the outbuilding could be saved.

If bats are present in the buildings, the demolition should not be allowed to take place.

The application states no public rights of way are near the building yet the site is flanked by public footpaths on two sides.

Demolition work is likely to further damage the drains causing problems upstream. This drain must be preserved and if necessary repaired.

No thought has been given to preservation of a building that is valued by local people. The very fabric of it is part of the local heritage which the owners and developers choose to ignore.
