- 4/25/2330/TPO Pruning of branches on black poplar tree - St Bees Priory. The Parish Council has no objections.
- 4/25/2340/TPO Crown reduction of red oak protected by a tree preservation order - Woodland View, 4 Fleatham Gardens. The Parish Council has no objections.
- 4/25/2329/TPO Pruning of branches and crown reduction of ash tree - 23 Main Street, St Bees. The Parish Council has no objections to the pruning of the overhanging branches. However, the tree is used by rooks who have nested in the tree earlier this year. The nests were blown down in the storm earlier this month but the rooks are still using the tree. The Parish Council would not wish to see any crown reduction affecting the rookery.
