Background

Its market focus is on the north of England region, with head office functions and 29 branches located in Tyne and Wear, Durham, Teesside, North Yorkshire, West Yorkshire, and Cumbria. The company is available to supply materials to both trade and private customers across the region. In recent years JT Atkinson has bought and rebranded Builders Supply (Kendal) Limited and recently received planning permission from the Lake District National Park Authority (LDNPA) to have a depot in Ambleside.
