Plate 7 – TP720E Trial Pit is covered with concrete hardstanding overlaying hardcore fill material, followed by red-brown gravelly clay.



Plate 8 – Spoil of TP720E. Yellow brown limestone underlies red-brown clay (excavation terminated at 1.9m bgl).



Plate 9 – TP730E covered with tarmac hardstanding underlain by hardcore fill material followed by dark brown sandy clay.



Plate 10 – TP730E. Brown sandy clay overlying pale grey-pink limestone (excavation terminated at 1.9m bgl).



Plate 11 – TP730E pale grey-pink fine grained limestone bedrock



Plate 12 – TP731E. Brown gravelly clayey silt overlays brown-orange gravelly clay followed by black clay at about 1.9m bgl. Grey limestone was encountered at base of this trial pit (terminated at 2.6m bgl).
