Pollution prevention measures

The following details are measures to prevent surface water runoff draining directly into the "Ouddan Estuary SSSI & Ramsar, Morecambe Bay SAC, & Morecambe Bay & Ouddan Estuary SPA" during excavation & track laying within the school playing field.

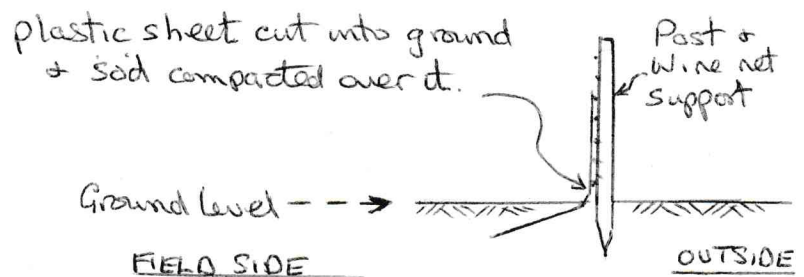
Before works commence, a plastic sheet bund is to be installed on all downsides of field slopes, approx 600mm high, against a post & wire net fence, with the inner edge of the plastic cut into the sod & same compressed back down over it, to prevent dirty water runoff if rain occurs during ground excavation works.

The bund should enclose the area around the floodgate & exit point of Salthouse pool at the southern corner of the field, from the railway line fence to the embankment between the grass playing field & the school yards/all weather playing field. (Points A to B on site plan)

A shorter section of bund should be installed between Salthouse Road boundary wall & the raised embankment near the entry point of Salthouse pool into the underground culvert. (Points C-D on site plan)

Once the works are complete, & all the turfs relaid to the sides of the track, these can be removed.

Whilst works commence, excess rainwater is to be allowed to drain away naturally through the ground.
