



OIL STORAGE TANK
Bunded tank on concrete slab N. T. S.

SCREEN PLANTING:

Screen planting to be provided in front of timber boarded fence to be made up of trees and shrubs with container grown saplings, approximately 60-80cm in height (depending upon species). Trees should be planted 2.5 metres apart as a random species mix all provided with support stakes and centre stem protection, hedge planting to be provided at 5 plants/m in staggered rows 500mm apart.

Tree species to be selected from:

- Bird cherry (*Prunus padus*), Rowan (*Sorbus aucuparia*), Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) or Holly (*Ilex aquifolium*).

Typical hedgerow planting mix:

- Carpinus betulus* (Common Hornbeam)
- Cornus sanguinea* (Common Dogwood)
- Corylus avellana* (Hazel)
- Crataegus monogyna* (Hawthorn)
- Eucrymyus europaea* (Spindle)
- Prunus spinosa* (Blackthorn)

GENERAL NOTES

All planting to be completed during first available season after completion of mound construction work and fully maintained thereafter.

Planting bed levels to be established in relation to existing ground contours, levels within any established tree root spread areas are not to be raised or lowered.

All new trees to be staked and tied with expanding collars and provided with suitable stem protection.
