Many thanks for your communication dated  $11^{th}$  September 2025. I wish to offer the following comments, which I have considered from a crime prevention perspective. I refer to my previous response dated  $25^{th}$  April 2025 under this reference, in which I highlighted various locations that lacked supervision - and I sought further information regarding various crime prevention measures for this development:

- boundary treatments (front curtilages)
- extent of the street lighting scheme
- dwelling exterior lighting
- protection of dwellings and garages against forced entry
- protection of sustainable energy equipment

From my interpretation of the Site Illustrative Masterplan (Amended Details September 2025), the locations lacking surveillance are still apparent.

Following perusal of the Design and Access Statement (Amended Details) I can find no additional detail regarding the security issues I previously raised.

It would therefore be helpful if the Applicant could respond as to how Policy DS4 is being implemented in these matters.
