# VARIATION OF CONDITION 4 FOLLOWING A GRANT OF PLANNING PERMISSION ROTHERY BARN CLEATOR MOOR CA25 5QS

#### **CONDITION 4**

Condition no 4 on the approval 4/14/2388/OF1 stated that the timber windows should be painted in a dark stain. The windows will be supplied by Westport and are high quality sliding sash styles. They have a pre finish sprayed at the factory and in discussions with them it was agreed that the windows would look much better if they were painted rather than stained.

It was a design decision and the barn is built of red local sandstone and if the windows were stained it would not allow the windows to stand out as a separate element of the external envelope of the building.

It is proposed to paint the windows in GRAVEL GREY which will contrast with the sandstone walls and allow the timber windows to be viewed as a separate part of the structure. The colour chosen complements with the stone walls producing an overall pleasing effect, when the barn is viewed from a distance.
