Thank you for your consultation on 7 June 2023 regarding the above Planning Application.

Cumberlnad Council as the Local Highway Authority (LHA) and Lead Local Flood Authority (LLFA) has reviewed the above planning reference and welcome the Construction phase traffic management plan written by Kingmoor Consulting Ltd in support of application 4/23/2025/0F1. We have reviewed the document/Information and our findings are detailed below.

Condition 3 - from the decision notice.

Pre-commencement Conditions

Development must not commence until a Construction Traffic Management Plan (CTMP) has been submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority. The CTMP shall include details of:

• Retained areas for vehicle parking, manoeuvring, loading and unloading for their specific purpose during the development;

construction vehicle routing;

• The management of junctions to and crossings of the public highway and other public rights of way/footway;

- Details of any proposed temporary access points; (vehicular / pedestrian)
