EARTHWORKS TO REGRADE THE LAND LEVELS

Thank you for your consultation on the above Discharge of Conditions Application.

The Local Highway Authority (LHA) and Lead Local Flood Authority (LLFA) has reviewed the revised proposals and can confirm as follows.

The changes are relatively minor and do not impact the highway in terms of trips and visibility. I note the proposed change to the surface water infiltration design, but this is also considered a minor change.

The conditions securing the visibility onto the highway and conditions seeking further designs for approval for the surface water drainage management are still in place. The proposals to be submitted to discharge these conditions will protect the highway and its users, as well as mitigate any increase in flood risk from the development.

The LHA and LLFA have no objection to these conditions being varied.
