Thank you for your consultation on the above Planning Application.

The Local Highway Authority (LHA) and Lead Local Flood Authority (LLFA) can confirm as follows:

We previously asked the applicant to provide further information.

As proposed on Visibility Splays - Amended June 2026. The 90m splays provided on the plan are acceptable, this is more than what we would need to see in this area.

An aco drain has been proposed at the entrance of the site, we are content with this.

I can confirm that we have no objections to the proposal, subject to the following recommended conditions being included in any Notice of Consent which may be issued:

Condition: The vehicular crossing over the footway, including the lowering of kerbs, shall be carried out to the specification of the Local Planning Authority in consultation with the Highway Authority.

Reason: To ensure a suitable standard of crossing for pedestrian safety.

Informative: Any works within or near the Highway must be authorised by the Council and no works shall be permitted or carried out on any part of the Highway including Verges, until you are in receipt of an appropriate permit from the LHA Streetworks team.
