Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the above planning application. This response from the Joint Emergency Management and Resilience Team relates to emergency planning arrangements in the unlikely event of an incident occurring at Sellafield Ltd. The Sellafield site is currently covered by the provision of the Radiation (Emergency Preparedness and Public Information) Regulations 2019.

The applicant should note that they **are required to** contact the Joint Emergency Management and Resilience office via [emergency.planning@westmorlandandfurness.gov.uk](mailto:emergency.planning@westmorlandandfurness.gov.uk) to ensure information about the development can be captured and the Sellafield Off Site Emergency Plan can be updated accordingly. The type of information required to be included in the plan is the location and type of development. This information is **vital** to ensure public protection is in place in the event of an incident at the Sellafield Site. This liaison is essential to ensure all occupants are aware of the appropriate information and actions to take should there be an incident at the Sellafield Site.

As the caravans are already in place this is a matter of urgency. We would like to gather this information for the plan and arrange a site visit.
