1.0 Proposal

- 1.1 This supporting statement has been prepared on behalf of the applicant to accompany of a planning application to vary a condition of an existing planning approval.
- 1.2 The application is submitted with regards to conditions 2, 15 & 16 of Planning Application 4/13/2148/0F1.
- 1.3 The title of the planning application was as follows:

'The reuse of previously developed site for a holiday development comprising 19 holiday units, a leisure facility, managers accommodation, formation of an access way and bridge over Dub Beck and a wildlife habitat management plan.'

1.4 The proposed amendment is a variation firstly of Condition 2, to include reference to window and roof details, which currently states:

Permission shall relate to the following plans and documents as received on the respective dates and development shall be carried out in accordance with them:-

Reason

To conform with the requirement of Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, as amended by the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004.

1.5 The removal of condition 15 is also requested in this application. This states as follows:

The windows and doors shall be of a timber construction and shall be maintained as such thereafter.

Reason

To ensure a satisfactory appearance of the development in the interests of visual amenity.

1.6 The variation of condition 16 is also required in this application. This states as follows:

The roof of the buildings shall be finished in natural slate, a representative sample of which shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority.

Reason

To safeguard the traditional appearance of the site in the interests of visual amenity.

- 1.7 The application is to amend the specification of windows from timber to aluminium framed windows, and for the proposed slate type.
- 1.8 The proposed window specification is:

Window Specification: AluFold Direct Slimline Aluminium Window in black.

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- 1.9 The proposed roofing slate is random green embelton slate.
- 1.10 Samples of both are available to be viewed on site.
- 1.11 The proposed materials have recently been approved by Copeland Borough Council on a similar new build residential farm type property within Weddicar Parish, so are considered to be acceptable for this type of development in this location.
