Worth noting that K-Rend has a tendency to stain after a few years, particularly under trees, so this may not remain looking fresh for very long. Cleaning it should remedy the problem though.

Also, the larch cladding will look very bright and orangey when it first goes in, so might attract some comments, but it will fade to a silvery grey within a few years.
