We have been asked by mr Jackson to carry out a report on a large mature elm tree that is situated on mr Jackson's property. The inspection was carried out by Mr Roberts who is the director of the company he also has over 40-years' experience as a tree arborist. He also is certified to identity Dutch elm disease.

Upon an inspection carried out 05/05/2021 our report on the condition and our recommendations are below:

The tree has a lot of die back at the top (Pictures of the tree are enclosed) with very small foliage for the tree this time of year. His conclusion is that the tree is suffering from Dutch elms disease and will most likely perish by the end of the year.

Mr Roberts feels that as time goes on the tree will become a danger to the public with branches falling due to the disease by falling into the road.

Our recommendation is for the tree to be felled and removed as there is a slim to non-chance that the tree will recover to health.
